The presentation was made on behalf of the Queen by the Lord Lieutenant and I was very proud to represent the Town - a great achievement for a Felixstowe-based company to be recognised in this way. The launch of Felixstowe in Flower was another highlight and the seafront beds and the Triangle look beautiful at the moment. The Mayor's Civic Service and Reception both showcased the two charities that I have chosen to support this year, namely Felixstowe Sea Cadet Unit and Felixstowe CAB. My reasons for choosing those particular organisations is that one supports young people and the other supports anyone who needs help and assistance with a multitude of problems. Town Council Grants

Does your organisation need funding? The Town Council has a total of £9,785 available to award to eligible organisations at the second and final round of its grant scheme this year. The deadline to apply for Round 2 is 30 November and completed applications received by this date for eligible projects will be considered by the Civic & Community Committee at its meeting in December. Full details of the eligibility criteria and how to apply can be found on our website at www.felixstowe.gov.uk/council-services/grants or by calling 01394 282086. Following the deadline for Round 1, Council's Civic & Community Committee awarded a total of £5,215 towards community projects at its meeting of 17th June.

Felixstowe Radio & TV: Awarded £575 towards the cost of relocating the aerial. The Hope Trust: Awarded £350 for the purchase of a new laptop for pastoral workers. Suffolk Accident Rescue Service (SARS): Awarded £350 towards equipping new SARS responders & upgrading existing equipment. Art on the Prom: Awarded £400 for the provision of one activity tent. Felixstowe Book Festival: Awarded £100 towards the core costs of the Book Festival. The Lions Club of Felixstowe: Awarded £1,500 towards a heart screening project for young persons.

Felixstowe Hockey Club: Awarded £1,290 for the cost of training new Hockey coaches. Felixstowe and District Horticultural Society: Awarded £150 towards venue hiring costs for the 2015 annual show. Felixstowe Friendly Visiting Service: Awarded £500 towards the cost of coach hire, lunches and teas for the elderly.

In addition, the Town Council provides regular annual support to a number of other local organisations. For 2015/16 these were: Art on the Prom: £500. Citizen's Advice Bureau: £1,500. Felixstowe Carnival: £500. Felixstowe Council for Sport and Recreation: £200. Felixstowe Ferry Boatyard: £200. Felixstowe Volunteer Coast Patrol Rescue: £1,500. Felixstowe/Harwich Ferry: £1,000. Landguard Fort: £1,000. Landguard Partnership: £1,000. Salzwedel Twinning Association: £200. Wesel Twinning Association: £200. Level Two Youth Project: £10,000.
