We were pleased to achieve a large discount off the retail price of this item, which resulted in a surplus of £61.00

On confirmation from the Felixstowe Town Council that we could use the surplus for other projects, we have decided to purchase some display boards to advertise our future productions.

The above amplifier has been hugely beneficial in improving the intensity of our rehearsals, resulting in us achieving complicated choreography, and much improved choral work.

Our objectives overall, although amateur in status, is to produce professional shows for the benefit of the inhabitants of Felixstowe and surrounding areas.

We wanted our next production to be one that we would be especially proud of, as we were returning to The Spa Pavilion after a gap of 8 years!

Sadly because of the coronavirus situation our show "Bless em all" which was due to be performed on May 11th 2020 at the Spa, has had to be postponed.

However we intend to carry on with show, at some future date, after the present crisis is over.
