Key Achievements

During 2017/18 Revitalise provided:

- Almost 4,400 breaks for disabled people and carers at our three centres in Southampton, Essex and Southport.
- Over 1,200 volunteering opportunities at our centres to ensure that all our guests had a break that offered fun, freedom and choice.
- Our Charity Shops benefitted from around 100 volunteers working to raise funds to support our activities.
- £620,000 from our hardship funds, enabling our most financially disadvantaged guests to access a much needed break. We continue to source income for this most valuable bursary fund.

How your grant will been used – activities and achievements

With your support our Felixstowe guests will benefit from 24 hour nurse led-care in a holiday environment, volunteer support and a choice of day trips and centre based activities and entertainment.

We have all the necessary equipment at our accessible holiday centres that many of our guests require including hoists and profiling beds, without it they may not be able to take a break at all. All our centres are registered with CQC and are led by a General Manager and a Head of Nursing who have many years experience, and are supported by our nursing team who provide high levels of bespoke care.
