Following a First Aid and Defibrillator course run at The Hub for volunteers we investigated how we could get a Defibrillator.

With the help of Lorna Bellamy Walton Parish Nurse who holds surgeries at St Philips Community Hub Wadgate Road Felixstowe and Shez from Level 2 we were successful in obtaining one.

St Philips Community Hub funded the installation and original costs and have agreed to ensure that all costs are covered moving forward. It has been accessed 5 times in the last 9 months proving that it is a vital lifesaving piece of equipment for the community.
