

Felixstowe Town CCTV Police Report – October to December 2017.

I have changed the details of the quarterly CCTV report to highlight some examples of incidents resulting in prosecution or formal action from the Police.

In some of the investigations the CCTV images have been the only reason a suspect was identified. In others the images have supplemented and assisted in corroborating witness or Police Officer evidence.

When we have a CCTV volunteer operator on duty the CCTV can be used to alert Police to incidents or monitor groups of people leaving the licenced venues on the sea front for example.

Court Results examples;

Hamilton Road 24/10/17 a 44 year old male headbutted a shop window causing a bullseye size hole and then assaulted his partner causing injuries. He then assaulted Constables during the arrest. He has subsequently received a 26 week prison sentence.

Hamilton Road 28/11/17 a 31 year old male threatened another male with a knife. CCTV helped to confirm the allegations made and identified the suspect who was subsequently arrested and charged to appear at the South East Suffolk Magistrates Court. He failed to appear at the Court and is currently at large.

Hamilton Road 25/12/17 a 21 year old male assaulted Officers after being arrested for 2 burglaries of Jewellery shops in the town centre. He has been charged and waiting for trial at Ipswich Crown Court.

It is my intention to continue to produce a quarterly CCTV report which will be made available to the council to help them evaluate the effectiveness of the CCTV system. If you have any feedback or questions relating to this report then please come back to me.
