

There is a total of £25,000 in the Occasional Grants budget available to award to eligible organisations in 2021/22. As this is the first of two funding rounds it is usual to limit the total awarded at this stage to £12,500. However, this may be exceeded if felt appropriate at this stage, however the overall total awarded in the full year 2021/22 cannot ordinarily exceed £25,000 without approval from Council.
