- Businesses that had just opened as lockdown happened included Alba Chiari and Crescent Café. Both have developed take out services and are looking forward to fully opening.

Negative news

- The Thrifty Thistle has confirmed closure. Two other known potential closures.

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Visit Felixstowe Heroes Campaign

- 20 informal Mayor zoom interviews with businesses have been completed with more in the pipeline.
- The aim has been to acknowledge the essential businesses that have stayed open, build momentum as the town and seafront re-opens and importantly, give reassurance to customers that appropriate social -distancing measures have been put in place. Campaign has been working in partnership with Felixstowe Radio and Felixstowe Chamber of Trade and Commerce.
- As an example: Underwood's video and associated post reached 14,495 and resulted in 2,153 engagements
