- Local Government Review The Boundary Committee's report concerning the structure of local government in Suffolk has now been delayed twice. The new date for publication is 15th July.
- Proposals for a South Felixstowe Conservation Area –
 Felixstowe has a wealth of interesting architecture much of
 which is already protected within a conservation area.
 There is currently a consultation about extending the

- Local Development Framework There has been wide consultation in Felixstowe about the Local Development Framework. This important document will outline the future for planning in our area. There has been a lot of local interest in the possible future location of new housing in the Felixstowe area. The Framework not only covers housing but every other aspect of planning. Local Councillors have held surgeries, the District Council has held road shows and the Town Council held its extraordinary meeting to discuss the Local Development Framework at the Orwell High School to enable as many people as possible to attend. This is a long term process on which no decisions have yet been taken and there will be more opportunities for your input during the further stages.
- Sea Defences Planning is starting for the next phase of the sea defences for Felixstowe. These will be from the War Memorial to Jacobs Ladder. A Stakeholders Group has been set up to include representatives of the businesses and others who will be affected by the sea defences. - Sport and Play for Young People Construction of the new skate park for Felixstowe will be starting soon. The skate park has received a major cash injection from the Government's Play Builder Fund. It is planned that the skate park project will be finished by the end of March. This will be an important and long awaited sporting facility for young people. New play equipment has now been installed at Eastward Ho and Cavendish Park. It is being well used and enjoyed by the young children who use these facilities.
