Vintage Car Rally & Fun Run Sunday 4th May

Location: Seafront, IP11 2AF

Over 500 vehicles, including cars, lorries, motorcycles, buses and military vehicles.

The vehicles assemble in Christchurch Park in Ipswich from about 10am, then start to leave for Felixstowe at 11.30am, where they are displayed along the promenade during the afternoon (from about 12noon onwards).

Felixstowe Fun Run Monday 5th May

Location: Seafront, IP11 2AF



The annual Rotary Club of Felixstowe's Fun Run will take place on Bank Holiday Monday, 5th May. The event is open to everyone and involves running or walking as many laps as possible around a measured mile circuit.





Entrants get a sponsor card providing an opportunity to seek sponsorship either for the whole run or on a 'per lap' basis to raise money for the charity or cause of their choice. All runners will receive an attractive memento certificate at the end. This year, the chosen prime beneficiary is Help for Heroes. Fancy dress is encouraged and prizes are awarded for the most eyecatching teams and individuals.

Entry fees: Over 16 years - £6 16 years and under - £4 Admission is free for spectators.

Registration on the day will take place from 9.30am onwards at the Town Hall at the bottom of Convalescent Hill. Fun Runners are asked to collect their running number at least 30 minutes before the start of the Fun Run.

The Fun Run starts at 11am and finishes at 12noon.

Women's Cycle Tour Friday 9th May

Location: Various locations throughout the town, IP11 2AF

Come and enjoy world-class women's cycling in Felixstowe - with the start of Stage Three of the new for 2014 Women's Tour. This is the country's first ever international stage-race, bringing the world's top riders to compete against Britain's Olympic heroines.



The Women's Tour is anticipated to attract not only Britain's Olympic stars like Laura Trott and Joanna Rowsell, but also the world's top professional cyclists, particularly those from the Benelux nations such as Marianne Vos (Rabobank Liv), Ellen Van Dijk (Boels Dolmans) and Liesbet De Vocht (Lotto Belisol).

The Women's Tour has been awarded the top status by cycling's governing body, the UCI, placing the race on a par with the Ladies Tour of Qatar and the Giro Rosa as one of the world's top ranked stage races.

The event will start at 11am, although competitors will be checking in from about 8am.

Everyone is welcome to come along to view the preparations and to line the route. For the first part of the route, the competitors will be in warm-up mode - from the seafront to the official start of the racing at the Howlett Road roundabout in The Trimleys.

The route for Stage Three will start on Felixstowe seafront (Undercliff Road West) from beside the War Memorial. It will then proceed along Sea Road, Beach Station Road, Langer Road, Orwell Road, Hamilton Road and High Road West. It will continue via Walton, Trimley St. Mary and Trimley St. Martin, before turning right at the roundabout onto Howlett Road - then over the A14 to pass Trimley St. Martin Primary School and through the village of Kirton. The route will then head to Ipswich and down through Essex to finish at Clacton.

Please note: there will be road closures on the day (and some car parks will be closed for event staff/officials), including part of Undercliff Road West, Bent Hill and Convalescent Hill. Road diversions will be in place.
