As the weather changes season and the autumn colours are in their full splendour, the town continues to offer a wide range of events and facilities for both residents and visitors to the town to enjoy. 2011 has been another busy year for the town with the completion of the Shared Space scheme on Hamilton Road, major coastal protection works well underway, and a successful bid to the Heritage Lottery Fund for funding to assist the Felixstowe Seafront Gardens Project. With the new Felixstowe Academy opening its doors at the start of the 2011/2012 academic year and the celebration of 125 years in the history of the Port of Felixstowe, coupled with the Grand Opening of internationally important new deep water berths at the Port, these are exciting times indeed.

Queen's Diamond Jubilee Celebrations

Along with many other communities, Felixstowe will be supporting the celebrations for the Queen's Diamond Jubilee.

The precise route for each Community on Route has not yet been confirmed at this stage however it will be a marvellous opportunity to be part of a unique and special event right on our doorsteps.

Grants to Local Organisations

Felixstowe Town Council supports many local organisations by means of a financial grant to support their work. In 2011/12 the Town Council made regular revenue grants to a number of organisations including the Felixstowe Old People's Welfare Association, the Felixstowe Wesel Committee, Felixstowe and District Council for Sport and Recreation, the Christmas Lighting scheme provided by the Felixstowe Lions Club, the Landguard Partnership, the Felixstowe Citizens Advice Bureau, the Felixstowe Carnival Association, Level2, the Felixstowe Bawdsey Foot Ferry, Art on the Prom, Orwell District Scouts and the Landguard Fort Trust.

Each year the Town Council also makes a number of occasional grants to local organisations. Suffolk Coastal District Council also provides grant aid and any organisation in Felixstowe applying to Suffolk Coastal District Council for grant aid also needs the support of the Town Council in its application to the District Council. If your organisation is making an application to Suffolk Coastal District Council, please make your application to the Town Council as soon as possible in order that the two applications can be co-ordinated. The Town Council usually considers in January all the applications for grants during the year. Should you wish to make an application to the Town Council for an occasional grant, please write to the Town Clerk with details of your request, your organisation and a copy of your most up to date accounts by Monday, 19th December.
