The Town Council is bringing extra festive fun to the town this year by arranging for a synthetic ice rink to be installed outside the East of England Co-

op at Great Eastern Square. The Mayor will open the ice rink at midday on Saturday 17th December and it will be available to use from Midday to 8pm each day until Wednesday 21st December (except Sunday 19th December when it will open from 10am - 6pm). Low-cost rides for smaller children and refreshments will also be available. Thanks to donations from County Councillors' Locality Budgets and sponsorship by the East of England Co-op, residents and visitors will be able to skate for FREE! Skates are provided too so you only need to turn up to have a go. Being here for 5 days means everybody will get a chance to skate but your time on the rink may be limited if it gets particularly busy.
