Census 2011

Every ten years, there is a national count of the population to assist in deciding how to plan, fund, and deliver everyday services, such as housing, education, healthcare and transport. This year the census will take place on 27th March 2011 and it is run by the Office of National Statistics. Every household will be required to fill in a questionnaire on or around this date, in order to take a snapshot of the population across the whole country.

The Office of National Statistics will send these questionnaires by post to every household in early March 2011, asking for information about each household and the people living or staying there on census day. Questionnaires can be completed either online, or on paper.



Most questions can be answered by ticking a box. The Office for National Statistics is planning to run a number of "completion events" locally to offer help in completing the forms. A census helpline is planned from 4th March 2011 and further information is available at www.census.gov.uk.

Challenging Times

There have been many reports of local services which are under review due to the budgetary constraints on all public services. Announcements have been made over recent weeks by Suffolk County Council, Suffolk Coastal District Council, Suffolk Police, Suffolk Fire and Rescue Service and Suffolk PCT.

The Town Council continues to recognise the importance of these services to the town, and their value to the community. The consultation phase is ongoing.

Digital Switchover



Television is changing, and in 2011 the traditional TV signal will be switched off in the Anglian region, and replaced with a digital TV signal. Switchover starts in the Anglia region in March 2011 and is due to end in November 2011. For Suffolk, the relevant dates are scheduled for between July and November 2011.

A Switchover Help Scheme has been set up by the Government and is run by the BBC. Its purpose is to make switchover to digital easier for certain eligible groups of older or disabled people by converting televisions in the run up to digital switchover.
