## Another Year of Change at the Town Council

#### 2015 Elections

New warding arrangements come in to effect from May which will see the number of District Councillors representing Felixstowe reduced from ten to eight. This means that there will be a higher proportion of 'Town only' Councillors out of the 16 elected to serve on the Town Council in May than there is at present.

#### **New Committee Structure**

Following a recent review, from May the overall number of Council's committees will reduce but each will be given increased responsibility for managing key areas of Council business. The four main bodies responsible for decision making, aside from full Council will be:

**Finance & General Purposes Committee** - Looking after the financial administration of the Council and reviewing Council policies.

**Assets & Services Committee** - Managing services provided by the Town Council.

**Civic & Community Committee** - Considering grants, Council events and communications.

**Planning & Environment Committee** - Considering Planning applications and consultations relating to the local environment.

#### Money Available for Local Organisations

More organisations in Felixstowe may be eligible to apply for one-off grants from the Town Council as additional funding becomes available from 1st April this year.
