# Hello from the Town Mayor



As I write this article, we're nearly three weeks into 2019, and Christmas 2018 is rapidly becoming a memory.

December was a remarkable month, starting with the Lights Switch-On (thanks to Cllr Tracey Green for officiating) and an excellent - much appreciated - Christmas Concert in aid of my two charities. This took place

whilst I was in China, having been invited to speak about Felixstowe's culture and tourism.

Our new dedicated PCSO, Ben Sagi, started work in the town in December. Don't forget that Ben has a monthly "surgery" in the Town Hall on a Monday morning. If you have a matter to bring to his attention, please phone the Town Hall to find out when the next session will take place.

On my return from Shanghai, we commenced the traditional Mayoral visits to Felixstowe's care homes, managing 14 in all! It was good to find residents in good heart, thanks to the dedicated care given by staff - the vast majority of whom are local residents. We owe them all a huge debt of gratitude.

After that we had the opening of the Ice Rink at Gt Eastern Square, which was once again a great success. Then on Christmas Day I joined more than 400 St Elizabeth's Hospice supporters in the traditional sea dip, followed by hospital visits and welcoming guests at the Salvation Army Christmas lunch.

Whilst January is traditionally a quiet month for the Mayor, we did of course commemorate the horrific floods of 31st January 1953 - the night when so many Felixstowe people lost their lives (or were bereaved) - at the memorial in Langer Road.

I close with a reminder that the Mayor's Charity Ball will be held on the evening of Friday 22nd March at the Orwell Hotel. # Community defibrillators reach double figures



Thanks to the generosity of The Felixstowe Society, the Town Council and the East of England Co-op have been able to host two further defibrillators in the town centre (outside the East of England Co-op store,

Hamilton Road, and the Senior Citizens Centre, Broadway House, Orwell Road). Felixstowe now has 10 of these devices, which are kept within secure high-visibility cabinets so that they can be accessed at all times in case of an emergency. For more details visit our website.
