TOWN TALK

Much has been happening in Felixstowe over the summer months including a successful Felixstowe Carnival, the first Beer at the Pier festival and Art on the Prom. Planning continues for more events in the town's calendar later in the year.

Felixstowe Seafront Gardens

In August, it was confirmed that the Felixstowe Seafront Gardens have been awarded funding of $\mathfrak{L}2.2$ million from the Heritage Lottery Fund which is marvellous news. There are exciting plans to restore and enhance the Seafront Gardens, which are appreciated by many and which contribute to the uniqueness of Felixstowe as a place to enjoy.

Now this next phase of funding has been confirmed, the work is scheduled to take place from September 2012, with an anticipated completion date towards the end of 2013. All are welcome to join the Friends of Felixstowe Seafront Gardens, a local group of volunteers who are interested in helping to support the improvements. Central Felixstowe Coast Protection Scheme

Another major scheme underway at present is the Central Felixstowe Coast Protection Scheme, which is being orchestrated by Suffolk Coastal District Council. The District Council have appointed Volker Stevin Ltd as their contractor. The £10 million scheme will provide vital coastal protection from the relentless natural elements. Works will be completed in two phases, and will consist of the demolition of the existing groynes and the construction of 18 rock groynes from the War Memorial to Cobbold's Point.

Phase 1, which is the construction of 9 rock groynes from Harvest House to Cobbold's Point, has already started, and is anticipated to be completed towards the end of the year. The beach area will then be recovered with a mixture of sand and shingle.

Work on Phase 2, which is the construction of the remaining 9 rock groynes, is scheduled from April to July 2012. It is also intended that a walkway will be constructed around Cobbold's Point to Jacob's Ladder.
