# **A Busy Summer of Activity**

Since the last edition of the newsletter, Felixstowe has hosted a number of successful events over the summer weeks which many residents and visitors have been able to enjoy.

Following on from the Olympic Torch Relay came the Felixstowe Fuschia Festival, the annual Darell's Day celebrations at Landguard Fort, the Felixstowe Horticultural Show, the Classic Car Show and other vehicle rallies including Hot Rods, to name but a few.

The August sunshine shone on crowds attending the annual Felixstowe Carnival weekend with its colourful array of floats and enthusiastic participants. Thanks must be extended to the Felixstowe Carnival Committee and their supporters for all the hard work involved in coordinating such an event.



Art on the Prom also drew large crowds who enjoyed a wide range of stalls and activities on an artistic theme. The Prom was transformed into an art haven, with displays of paintings, models, accessories, glassware, cartoons, pop art, traditional watercolours and a colourful beach



installation of items found on the beach to name but a few. With music and refreshments too, it was a marvellous event. Thanks must also be extended to the organisers of Art on the Prom, Mary and Stephen Wyatt, for all their hard work in bringing the event together. Next year's date for Art on the Prom 2013 has provisionally been set for Sunday 1st September, which will also be its 10th anniversary. In September, a wide variety of local buildings and organisations threw open their doors as part of the nationally run Heritage Open Days scheme. The aim of the scheme is to enable people to come and see places over one weekend which are connected with local heritage and which might not otherwise be visited.

Judging by the large number of Heritage Open Days running over the weekend of 8th / 9th September, Felixstowe has a sizeable number of interesting places as part of its rich local heritage. The Town Hall took part in the scheme and a number of people joined guided tours and learned more about the building and its many uses.

# Remembrance Sunday 2012

The Town Council is co-ordinating the civic commemoration for Remembrance Sunday. This year, the eleventh day of the eleventh month falls on a Sunday.

The Remembrance Service will take place at Trinity Methodist Church, starting at 9.45 am. Following the church service, an Act of Remembrance will take place at 10.50 am at the War Memorial on the seafront by the Town Hall. In accordance with the tradition, wreaths will be laid and respects will be paid to those involved in conflict, both past and present. All are welcome to attend.



The Town Council also wishes to recognise, thank and pay tribute to Reverend Ken Martin who

for many years has led the Act of Remembrance at the War Memorial on Remembrance Sunday. After 22 years, The Sailors' Society has made his post as Port Chaplain at the Seafarers Centre redundant, and Reverend Martin's future is therefore obliged to take a different direction. His leading of the Act of Remembrance was in his capacity as Chaplain to the Royal British Legion, a role now capably assumed by Reverend Mark Kichenside.

A new website has been launched to provide helpful information about what there is to see and do in Felixstowe. It builds on the work previously done to establish the "Felixstowe Great Days By The Sea" strapline and logo which is becoming more widely known and used.
