Wings on Waves - A Great Success!

On Sunday 4th August, the Town Council co-ordinated a spectacular event called Wings on Waves to celebrate the 100th Anniversary of Sea Planes in Felixstowe.

The events on 4th August started with a special Church Service at St. John's Church led by The Right Reverend Nigel Stock, Bishop of St. Edmundsbury and Ipswich. The service included a procession of standards, the poem 'High Flight' in tribute to pilots and The Dam Busters March as recessional music. Particular thanks to the Priest in charge, the Reverend Robert Hinsley, for a most fitting service. This Service was followed by a Seafront Parade past the Town Hall where a salute was taken by the Mayor of Felixstowe and Group Captain G A Bunkell, Inspector of the Royal Auxiliary Air Force Regiment. The parade which was led by the Harwich Pipe Band consisted of many standards, able bodied veterans and units from Felixstowe Sea Cadets, Felixstowe Army Cadet Force and Felixstowe Air Training Corps.

An exciting Air Display was held over the seafront. The beach, promenade and cliff tops were packed with spectators looking to the skies for a series of fly pasts and aerobatic demonstrations. The Catalina Flying Boat (sponsored by the wonderful generosity of the Port of Felixstowe), was the star of the show along with a Spitfire, Yak52 and other aircraft. Local businesses and community groups provided stalls along the Promenade. The sun shone and the crowds enjoyed the day's celebrations.

10th Anniversary of Art on the Prom

The remainder are funded directly by the Town Council who also fund their watering and maintenance. Summer visitors have remarked upon how lovely the hanging baskets look, particularly the stretch along Sea Road on the seafront, which is welcome feedback.

Over the summer months, the Town Council has also run a whole series of competitions for Felixstowe in Flower which has been well supported. A ceremony to announce the winners was held in September and the names of the winners will be announced in the next edition of the newsletter.

Remembrance 2013

On Sunday 10th November, Remembrance Sunday, the annual Civic Remembrance Service will take place at 9.45am at the Parish Church of St John the Baptist, followed by the Act of Remembrance at the War Memorial at the seafront for 11am. Wreaths will be laid and a two minute silence kept at 11am.



On Monday 11th November, on Armistice Day itself, a two minute silence will also be observed at the War Memorial. Everyone is welcome to attend both of these important events.
