

Felixstowe Town CCTV Police report – April to June 2015.

This is the third quarterly report for the Felixstowe CCTV project and is intended to give a brief summary of the volume and type of crimes and incidents that the volunteers and Police deal with in the areas covered by the existing cameras.

The following spreadsheet lists the incidents and details in five columns as stated below together with the top line results.

- Column A lists the location of the incident – we have recorded incidents across 9 cameras. There are no incidents recorded for Garrison Lane this quarter.
- Column B lists the date of the incident – April to June 2015
- Column C lists the Police crime or incident number – we have a total of 113 incidents this quarter Vs. 80 and 89 in the last two quarters respectively. Hamilton Road has the largest number of incidents recorded with 41 , followed by Sea Road and Undercliff Road at 24 and 18 respectively.
- Column D lists a description of the Crime or incident (RTC) stands for Road Traffic Collision – there are numerous offence categories with 40% being theft or burglary. The next largest category of offences is assault including GBH 16%.
- Column E indicates by an asterisk if a suspect has been identified if relevant – 31 suspects have been identified.

As you can see, there is a fairly broad range of incidents that have occurred in these areas and I have not included every type of incident such as littering or parking offences, but I have chosen the type of incidents that the CCTV evidence is generally used.

In some of the investigations the CCTV images have been the only reason a suspect was identified. In other incidents the images have supplemented and assisted in corroborating witness or Police Officer evidence.

When we have a CCTV operator on duty the CCTV can be used to alert Police to incidents or monitor groups of people leaving the licenced venues on the sea front for example.

During this quarter I have calculated that the CCTV volunteers have given 175.5 hrs of their time in monitoring and operating the cameras. The majority of the hours were between 2200hrs and 0300hrs at weekends to cover the Night Time Economy periods.

One of the new volunteers has now started to monitor during commercial hours in the town centre, which will improve the service to retailers.

We currently have 8 active volunteers available to monitor the CCTV system.

A number of Police Officers are also trained in downloading images from the system to a suitable disc exhibit for evidential purposes.

We are keeping records of when a fault is reported to the contactors STC, and when these are repaired.

I hope you find the report of some use in determining the value and effectiveness of the system. I welcome any feedback or suggestions on alterations to the report for future quarters.

I have been invited to attend the Civic & Community Committee in September in order to talk about the Town CCTV system and the current arrangements.
