

Felixstowe Town CCTV Police Report – October to December 2016.

This quarterly report for the Felixstowe CCTV partnership is intended to give a brief summary of the volume and types of incidents and crimes the Police and CCTV volunteers deal with in the general areas covered by the existing cameras.

I have attached a spreadsheet that lists the incidents and details in five columns as stated below.

Column A lists the location of the incident.

Column B lists the date of the incident between 1st of October 2016 and the 31st of December 2016.

Column C lists the Police investigation or incident number – There are a total of 67 listed this quarter with Hamilton Road having the most incidents with 30 in this time period.

Column D is the description of the crime or incident. RTC stands for Road Traffic Collision

Column E indicates by an asterisk if a suspect has been described or identified if relevant. In 39 of the 67 incidents there is a suspect recorded on the investigations.

As you can see, there is a fairly broad range of incidents that have occurred in these areas and I have not included every type of incident such as littering or parking offences. I have chosen the type of incidents that the CCTV evidence is generally used.

In some of the investigations the CCTV images have been the only reason a suspect was identified. In others the images have supplemented and assisted in corroborating witness or Police Officer evidence.

When we have a CCTV volunteer operator on duty the CCTV can be used to alert Police to incidents or monitor groups of people leaving the licenced venues on the sea front for example.

Since the previous report there has been the addition of a further 6 cameras and an extensive upgrading programme which has included the cameras to HD quality. During the upgrades there have been a number of reliability issues that have resulted in the malfunction and periods of downtime while the contractors STC have worked on the system. This has also resulted in a reduction of volunteers and the amount of time that they have been able to monitor the cameras in the control room at the Police station.

However recently many of these issues have now been resolved and soon the monitoring office will be relocated to the new jointly shared premises at the Fire

station. The facility there will be much improved and more comfortable than the soon to be vacated Police station building.

I have recently interviewed 2 potential new volunteers that following an induction process will be available to join existing members bringing us up to 7 volunteers.

Most of the existing volunteers mainly monitor the cameras on Friday and Saturday evenings between 2200hrs and 0300hrs. This is to cover the Night Time Economy periods.

Another volunteer mostly comes in on Saturday afternoons to cover the busier times during the commercial hours of the town centre.

Following the system upgrades, it is my intention to continue to produce a quarterly CCTV report which will be made available to the council to help them evaluate the effectiveness of the CCTV system. If you have any feedback or questions relating to this report then please come back to me.
