### **Felixstowe Town CCTV Police report: 1 January - 31 March 2017.**

This quarterly report for the Felixstowe CCTV partnership is intended to give a brief summary of the volume and types of incidents and crimes the Police and CCTV volunteers deal with in the general areas covered by the existing cameras.

The following spreadsheet lists the incidents and details in five columns.

- Column A lists the location of the incident
- Column B lists the date of the incident between 1<sup>st</sup> of January 2017 and the 31<sup>st</sup> of March 2017.
- Column C lists the Police crime or incident number– There are a total of 67 listed this quarter with Hamilton Road having the most incidents with 30 in this time period.
- Column D lists a description of the Crime or incident. RTC stands for Road Traffic Collision
- Column E indicates by an asterisk if a suspect has been identified if relevant. In 9 of the 70 incidents there is a suspect recorded on the investigations.

As you can see, there is a fairly broad range of incidents that have occurred in these areas and I have not included every type of incident such as littering or parking offences. I have chosen the type of incidents that the CCTV evidence is generally used.

In some of the investigations the CCTV images have been the only reason a suspect was identified. In others the images have supplemented and assisted in corroborating witness or Police Officer evidence.

When we have a CCTV volunteer operator on duty the CCTV can be used to alert Police to incidents or monitor groups of people leaving the licenced venues on the sea front for example.

Generally the system has been much more reliable as technical issues were addressed by the contractors STC through the quarter and soon the monitoring office will be relocated to the new jointly shared premises at the Fire station. The facility there will be much improved and more comfortable than the soon to be vacated Police station building.

2 new volunteers have joined following an induction process bringing us up to 7 active volunteers. When we have relocated and made sure the system is fully functional over at the new SNT base we will look to recruit additional volunteers.

Most of the existing volunteers monitor the cameras on Friday and Saturday evenings between 2200hrs and 0300hrs. This is to cover the Night Time Economy periods.

Another volunteer mostly comes in on Saturday afternoons to cover the busier times during the commercial hours of the town centre.

### **Court Results examples;**

**Hamilton Road 16/01/2017 Stuart Johnson** was located in Greggs Bakery by an off duty officer and subsequently arrested for an unrelated matter. At the time of his arrest he was found in possession of a small amount of drugs and two bladed articles. At the subsequent trial at Ipswich Crown Court he was convicted and sent to prison for 8 months.

**Bent Hill 22/01/2017 Ilmals BORODOVSKS** was charged with possession of a Class A drug (Cocaine) and being Drunk and Disorderly in a Public place.

At the subsequent trial hearing he pleaded guilty and was fined £300 and had to pay a further £30 victim services surcharge and £85 costs for drugs offence. He was fined a further £100 for the Drunk and Disorderly matter.

**Bent Hill 28/01/2017 Ellen Meikle** was arrested after punching and smashing a glass window of a gallery window. She injured her hand as a result and received a Police conditional caution which included paying compensation for the damaged window.

It is my intention to continue to produce a quarterly CCTV report which will be made available to the council to help them evaluate the effectiveness of the CCTV system. If you have any feedback or questions relating to this report then please come back to me.
