In order to enhance and expand the station, and ensure a secure future, Felixstowe Radio recently underwent a move to Felixstowe Academy site. To give ourselves a wider outreach on the airwaves our aerial was then moved from the top of the Orwell Hotel and placed on the roof of Felixstowe Academy. A team of 8, including 2 from the UK's communications regulator Ofcom, undertook the task and were delighted that through this move we are now able to be heard loud and clear, to not only Felixstowe and its surrounding villages, but also to Woodbridge, East Ipswich and Harwich.

It is with the help and support of Felixstowe Town Council we were able to undertake the aerial move and continue to provide you with your very own community radio station.
