

COMMUNITY INFRASTRUCTURE LEVY ANNUAL REPORT 2017/18

Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) is a charge on new development that is collected by Suffolk Coastal District Council (SCDC) to provide additional funding to help pay for new and improved infrastructure.

Suffolk Coastal District Council pays Felixstowe Town Council 15% of CIL receipts for developments in its area and Felixstowe Town Council must use CIL receipts passed to it for (a) the provision, improvement, replacement, operation or maintenance of infrastructure; or (b) anything else that is concerned with addressing the demands that development places on an area.

The Town Council is required by Regulations to publish a formal report on each year's CIL receipts, Annual Reporting by Local Councils Regulation 62A, Community Infrastructure Levy Regulations (2010), as amended.

The following details relate to the period 1 April 2017 to 31 March 2018:
