Christmas Wishes from the Town Mayor



When you look back over 2018, it will surely be remembered as a momentous year for Felixstowe. We enjoyed one of the longest summer seasons I can remember for many years, blessed with record high temperatures, successive dry days and glorious sunshine. More recently we have commemorated 100 years

since the signing of the Armistice and the cessation of hostilities in World War 1. I believe the latter was particularly significant for the town, given our proximity to the sea and mainland Europe, and our special relationship with the Armed Forces - our former Royal Naval Air Station being strategically important at the time of the creation of the Royal Air Force on 1 January 1918.

Thus, Remembrance was commemorated in numerous activities throughout the town, culminating in what must have been our best attended service at the War Memorial in recent years, and the evening's moving Beacon Lighting ceremony - a tribute to the 163 Felixstowe men who were lost to the Great War.

The Town Council played a significant role in pulling the major civic events together and producing a commemorative programme, for which I thank our staff, the Royal British Legion, local clergy, our schools, and many other official and voluntary organisations throughout the town.

On behalf of all your Town Councillors, and the staff of both the Town Hall and the Cemetery, I would like to wish you and your families a joyous Christmas and a successful and healthy New Year.


