

**SUFFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (DISTRICT OF SUFFOLK COASTAL) (STOPPING,
WAITING AND LOADING PROHIBITIONS AND RESTRICTIONS AND ON-STREET
PARKING PLACES) (MAP-BASED) ORDER 2019 (FELIXSTOWE) (B1082 HAMILTON
ROAD) (PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES AND LIMITED WAITING) (VARIATION
NO.16) ORDER 202-**

Suffolk County Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 9 and 10 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, (hereinafter referred to as 'the Act of 1984') and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order:

1. Any reference in this Order to a numbered Article is a reference to the Article bearing that number in this Order.
2. The restrictions, prohibitions and requirements imposed by this Order are in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction, prohibition or requirement imposed by any other enactment and any exception or exemption to the provisions of this Order is without prejudice to the provisions of any other enactment.

Part 1: Waiting Restrictions

3. The provisions of the Suffolk County Council (District of Suffolk Coastal) (Stopping, Waiting and Loading Prohibitions and Restrictions and On-Street Parking Places) (Map-Based) Order 2019 (the "2019 Order"), as amended, shall have effect as if set out in full in this Order, save that revision 0 of the Map Tile bearing reference HP150 shall be replaced by the amended revision 2 of Map Tile HP150 attached to this Order, and Schedule 1 of the 2019 Order shall be amended accordingly.

Part 2: Prohibition of Motor Vehicles with Exemptions

4. Except as provided in Article 5, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed in the B1082 Hamilton Road, Felixstowe from its junction with Orwell Road to its junction with Cobbold Road between the hours of 10am – 4pm.
5. Nothing in Article 4 shall make it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the length of road specified therein to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely:
 - (a) police operational, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
 - (b) building, industrial or demolition operations;
 - (c) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (d) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said length of road;
 - (e) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or on land adjacent to the said length of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications system as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;
 - (f) if it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes in any other road, to be used in the service of a local authority or of a water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties; or

(g) refuse vehicles authorised and given the responsibility by East Suffolk Council to collect rubbish and waste.

6. Nothing in Article 5 shall make it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the length of road referred to therein to gain access to or egress from land or premises accessible only from that length of road.

Part 3: General Provisions and Citation

7. This Order may be cited as the Suffolk County Council (District of Suffolk Coastal) (Stopping, Waiting and Loading Prohibitions and Restrictions and On-Street Parking Places) (Map-Based) Order 2019 (B1082 Hamilton Road) (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles and Limited Waiting) (Variation No.16) Order 202- and shall come into operation on []

Schedule 1

Hamilton Road Felixstowe (A1021) From its junction with Cobbold Road (U3126) to its junction with Orwell Road (A1021), no motor vehicle can enter, so motor vehicles are prohibited daily from 10am to 4pm. Outside of these hours loading and disabled drivers (blue badge holders) are permitting access.

There are bays for disabled parking located 79-81 Hamilton Road, 55-55 Hamilton Road and 34-38 Hamilton Road. See plan.
