

SUFFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (DISTRICT OF SUFFOLK COASTAL) (STOPPING, WAITING AND LOADING PROHIBITIONS AND RESTRICTIONS AND ON-STREET PARKING PLACES) (MAP-BASED) ORDER 2019 (FELIXSTOWE) (B1082 HAMILTON ROAD) (PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES AND LIMITED WAITING) (VARIATION NO.16) ORDER 202-

Suffolk County Council proposes to make the above order under Sections 9 and 10 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The order will introduce a prohibition of motor vehicles on Hamilton Road, Felixstowe from its junction with Orwell Road to its junction with Cobbold Road between the hours of 10am – 4pm. Furthermore, the Order will also amend the 3 existing 'Loading Only/Disabled Badge Holders Only Any Day 3hrs No Return Within 4hrs' bays on Hamilton Road, so that these bays are only useable 12am-10am and 4pm-12am (i.e. outside of the hours of the road closure).

Exemptions to the prohibition of motor vehicles restriction allow vehicles being used to gain access to and from land or premises on Hamilton Road, refuse vehicles, maintenance and utility vehicles or emergency vehicles to continue to proceed in Hamilton Road during the restricted hours for those reasons only.
