



Flag Flying at Felixstowe Town Hall

The default flag flying from Felixstowe Town Hall shall be the Felixstowe Town Council Flag.

The Union Flag will fly solo on the following days:

- **St George's Day:** 23 April
- **Official Birthday of His Majesty The King:** 15 June
- **Armistice Day:** 11 November
- **Remembrance Sunday:** Second Sunday in November
- **Birthday of His Majesty The King:** 14 November

The following other flags will be flown on the occasions below:

- **Commonwealth Day (Commonwealth Flag):** Second Monday in March
- **Pride Month (Progress Pride Flag):** 1 June until the King's Official Birthday
- **Suffolk Day (Suffolk Flag):** 21 June
- **Armed Forces Day (Armed Forces Day Flag):** 25 June
- **Merchant Navy Day (Red Ensign):** 3 September
- **Fairtrade Fortnight (Fairtrade Flag):** Second Monday in September

In addition, the Town Council will continue to fly the flag of Ukraine in solidarity to Ukraine on the anniversary of the illegal invasion by Russia on 24 February 2022 until such time as the Council decides.

Authority is delegated to the Town Clerk, in consultation with the Mayor and Chairman of the Civic & Community Committee, to consider other flag flying days, not included in the list above.

Policy Approved: Civic & Community Committee 9 October 2024.

Review Body: Civic & Community Committee.

Review Period: Every four years, or sooner as may be required.

Next Review: C&C (October 2029).
