



Flag Flying at Felixstowe Town Hall

The Union Flag shall fly on all days on the Town Hall flagpole.

Often, the Union Flag will fly with the Felixstowe Town flag below it on the same flagpole.

However, the Union Flag will fly solo on the following days:

- **14 March:** Commonwealth Day (second Monday in March)
- **23 April:** St George's Day (in England)
- **11 November:** Armistice Day
- **13 November:** Remembrance Day (second Sunday in November)
- **14 November:** Birthday of His Majesty The King

In addition, other appropriate flags will be flown secondary to the Union Flag for the following occasions (dates for 2024):

- **14 March:** Commonwealth Day (Commonwealth Flag)
- **June:** Pride Month (Progress Pride Flag)
- **21 June:** Suffolk Day (Suffolk Flag)
- **25 June:** Armed Forces Day (Armed Forces Day Flag)
- **5 July:** NHS and Frontline Workers Day (NHS and Frontline Workers Day Flag)
- **3 September:** Merchant Navy Day (Red Ensign)
- **9 September:** Emergency Services Day (Emergency Services Day Flag)

Felixstowe Town Council will follow the designated days when the Union Flag should be flown on UK government buildings by command of His Majesty the King as per the guidance here:
