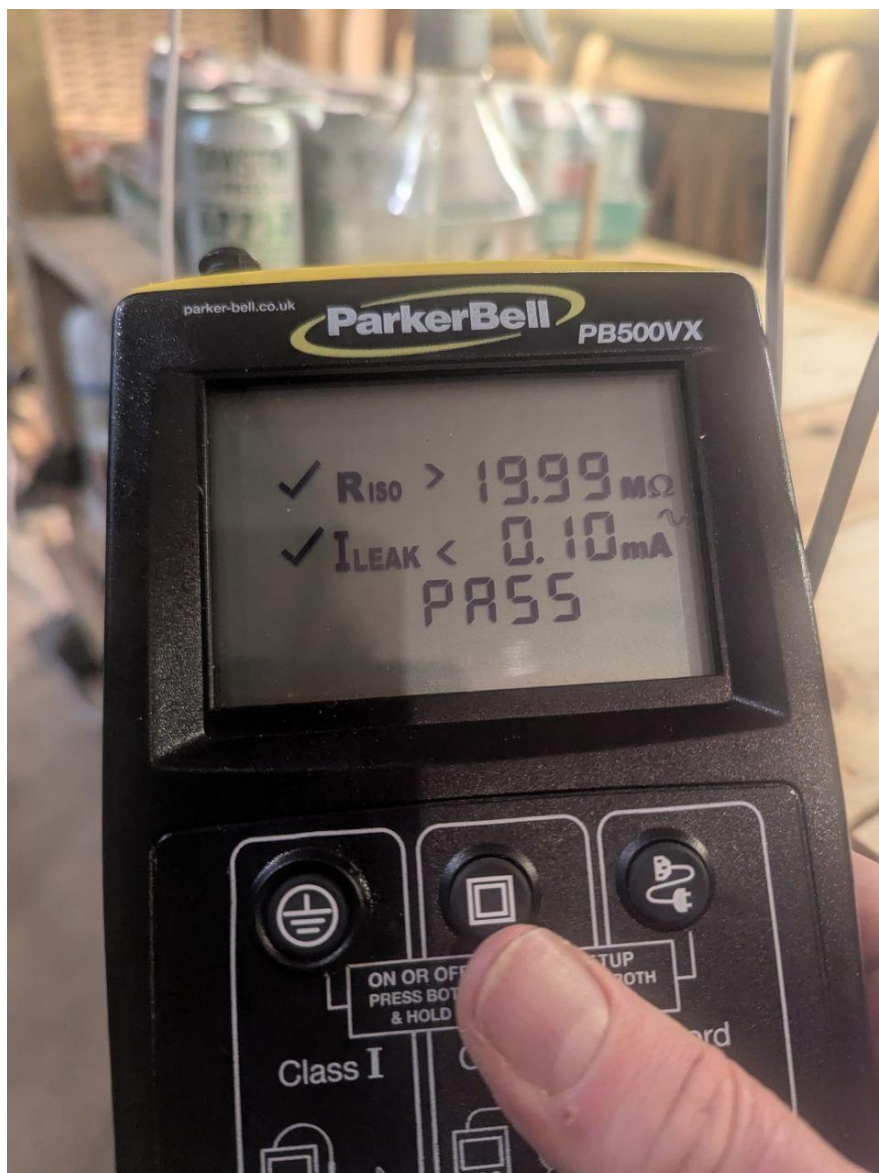


Cuppa Repair cafe

The repair cafe at Cuppa has now been running for 12 months during which time we have saved xxx items going to landfill, whilst helping to build links between people within the community.

The PAT machine has now been recalibrated by the manufacturer thanks to the grant received from the Town Council. It continues to perform a vital role in the repair process, ensuring that repairers and reparaees(?) are kept safe. This year it has helped repair a CD player, several lamps, a dehumidifier, kettles, a toaster, a radio to name but a few.

Thanks to the PAT training that was purchased with last year's grant we are able to have a number of people on hand to perform the tests.

The grant also allowed us to purchase a thermal camera to assist with diagnosing electronic component failures. I'm told by the repairers it will be very useful as faulty bits often get hot.
