



Felixstowe Radio is the only Community Radio station in Felixstowe with an FM licence with a reach of approximately 10 miles, also to Harwich, Shotley and Bawdsey.

Our plan is to offer our services to more organisations and events to broaden our reach, improve our community engagement, supporting young people and the elderly and raise the profile of the work in the town and beyond.

We are grateful for support from the Felixstowe Town Council to secure a dedicated portable kit for outside broadcasts

.So we can engage in the community, promote Felixstowe and ourselves in appropriate ways, we applied to secure funding for a gazebo, speakers and stands for a professional image and our own technology for broadcast capability.

Our CD player had reached the end of life, and many presenters prefer to use CDs rather than digital music. In order to support the provision of a wide variety of shows with specialist genres a CD player is essential kit.

In the last year we have presented outside broadcasts for multiple organisations; including in the Town Hall for the Town Council on the return of the Mayor's charity cycle ride, in the Town centre for the Felixstowe lighting up day and the carnival and for the Mayor's bargain hunt, at Landguard Fort, at the Love to Work in Felixstowe Careers event at the Leisure Centre, at Easton Farm Park. We broadcast a live quiz from Sea You on 5th December in partnership with the Chamber of Commerce and Felixstowe School, Landguard Fort on 8th December, Whisstocks Boatyard in Woodbridge on 14th December and Christmas Church services with Christchurch. There are plans to support an event for the Felixstowe Rugby Club, and Easter broadcasts, and the Carnival in July.

We have acquired and are awaiting delivery of professionally presented equipment to be sustainable and corporately effective for the community. We also require weatherproofing in the form of a branded dedicated Felixstowe Radio gazebo
