The Festival is grateful for the support of Felixstowe Town Council which helped to make our 2025 event such a success, bringing into Felixstowe people from far and wide. 66% of those surveyed had come from outside Felixstowe, including Norfolk, London, Cambridge and Peterborough. 36% were attending the Festival for the first time

The Festival programme offered something for everyone. Highlights were the talks by Rev Richard Coles and novelist Tracy Chevalier. Also popular were the talks by Jenny Boyd of Fleetwood Mac and celebrations of the work of P D James and Ronald Blythe. Other topics covered were neurodiversity and environmental justice

Feedback was very positive, commenting on the excellence of the talks and the friendly welcoming atmosphere.

The 2026 programme includes best selling, award winning authors such as Dame Jacqueline Wilson, Robin Ince, Patrick Gale, Sir Terry Waite and Sarah Perry. Subjects covered include our relationship with animals and the countryside, free speech, the Boleyn women and the reign of James 1st.
