This was the inaugural year of the schools 'Design a Window' competition that saw more than two hundred Y5 students across the town and surrounding villages use their imaginations to create new displays. The winner, Maya Rusu, was presented to the town on Light Up Day and her creation was given pride of place before the main switch on. Her display will now be given a place somewhere around the town for the next 30 years or so until all the other displays have been given the Y5 makeover.

The Lions Club of Felixstowe Other Activities

The Lions organise a number of fund raising activities throughout the year (The Pig Race, Model Truck Exhibition, Dog Show, Golf Day, Model Railway Exhibition, Christmas Light Up Day etc).
